Dear Mr. Talon:

A careful review of your application and physical examination performed on September 20, 2003, discloses that you do not meet the medical standards prescribed in Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR's), Part 67. By virtue of your failure to provide requested information as outlined in our letter dated November 17, 2003, it has been determined that you are not qualified for any class of medical certificate at this time.
