Dear Mr. Jeffrey A. Talon:

This will acknowledge receipt and review of your physical examination dated September 20, 2003. In a letter to you dated March 6, 2003, and August 2, 2002, you were asked to undergo a psychiatric and psychological evaluation, a functional capacity evaluation, and to have those reports forwarded to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) office in Washington, D.C. We have received the report of your psychiatric evaluation performed by Dr. Daniel Polster on January 16, 2003. Because the only source of this information was a single 50-minute interview with you, and we were unable to discuss with Dr. Polster his findings, this limited evaluation did not provide enough information for the Federal Air Surgeon (FAS) to determine your eligibility for medical certification.

For purposes of the FAS determination, a psychiatric and psychological evaluation includes the following:

1. Detailed psychiatric interview(s).
2. Complete psychiatric-psychological testing.
3. Review and analysis by your examining psychiatrist of your entire FAA medical file (all records and information that you have provided to the FAA in support of your appeal to the FAS).
4. Full sharing by your examining psychiatrist of the above the results with the FAA office of Aerospace Medicine. This includes any discussions with the examining psychiatrist the FAS deems necessary to determine your eligibility for medical certification.

This psychiatric evaluation, should preferably, be accomplished by Dr. David Altman since he has evaluated you in the past and is familiar with you. His telephone number, should decide to have your evaluation performed by Dr. Altman, #(847) 674-2025.

Additionally, in our letter to you dated August 2, 2002, we requested a report of a current Functional Capacity Evaluation by a certified disability examiner, preferably the same examiner who evaluated you on March 6, 2001, (Preston B. Fitzgerald, Sr., M.D.). This evaluation should also include review by the examiner of your March 6, 2001, Functional Capacity Evaluation. To date, we have not received a copy of a current Functional Capacity Evaluation from you.
